USC Moreton Bay campus opened in 2020. As the first purpose-built university for the Moreton Bay region, this is a timely investment in Australia's third largest local government area and one of the country's most dynamic growth regions.

The Moreton Bay campus is part of the continuing growth of the University of the Sunshine Coast. As one of Australia's fastest growing regional universities, USC is enriching our regions, connecting with our communities and creating opportunities for all.

In 2022, USC Moreton Bay employs approximately 200 staff delivering over 60 degrees to more than 3,000 students. Enrolments are expected to grow to 10,000 students by 2030.

USC Moreton Bay provides lifelong learning opportunities for all members of the community, from bridging courses and undergraduate degrees to postgraduate study and research.

Stage Two is now underway with new buildings, facilities and outdoor spaces opening in 2023.

STAGE TWO Opening in 2023

As our student population and academic activities continue to grow, Stage Two will deliver new buildings, spaces and places for teaching, research, sport and recreation.

Facilities will include:

Designed by Brisbane-based architectural practice KIRK, the Stage Two developments continue to bring the USC Moreton Bay masterplan and vision to life.



Research for our region

USC Moreton Bay is conducting research of strategic significance for our region. From climate change adaptation to regional healthcare, koala health and preservation to advanced manufacturing, we work to solve problems that directly impact where we live and work.

The Pēpi-Pod® Program, for instance, is the first Australian research trial of a portable infant sleep space designed to support breastfeeding and facilitate mother-baby proximity on the same sleep surface, while reducing the risk of sleep-related infant mortality.

Our new research facilities will pave the way for USC Moreton Bay as a national centre for innovation.

USC Caboolture — more pathways for Moreton Bay

With nursing degrees, health certificates and bridging courses, USC Caboolture provides more opportunities for the Moreton Bay region. As a shared campus with TAFE Queensland, students can progress from vocational training to university degree studies on the one campus. Teaching and learning are delivered in state-of-the-art nursing labs and simulation spaces.

Shaping the future of our region

USC Moreton Bay campus is the heart of the burgeoning Mill at Moreton Bay — the visionary redevelopment of the Petrie Paper Mill site. As a priority development area for Moreton Bay Regional Council, the Mill at Moreton Bay will become a vibrant and diverse community in which to live, learn, work, play and build a bright and sustainable future.

USC Moreton Bay is the cornerstone of a 20 year plan to foster a \$40 billion local economy and 100,000 jobs for the region.


